

Andrei Belgrader is a theatre and television director who has also been a master teacher at the Yale School of Drama, a professor at UCSD and Head of the Directing Department at Juilliard. On television, he has directed numerous episodes of *Monk* as well as *Law & Order: Criminal Intent* and the sitcom *Coach*. He directed extensively at major regional theatres such as the American Repertory Theatre, Yale Repertory, the Goodman and Seattle Repertory, as well as in New York City. Projects in New York include Beckett's *Endgame* at BAM, with John Turturro and Elaine Stritch, and *The Cherry Orchard* at CSC, with Dianne Wiest, John Turturro and Michael Urie. Both productions were named among the 10 best productions of the year in major publications such as The New York Times and New York magazine. *The Cherry Orchard* was awarded the Lucille Lortel Award for Best Revival in 2012. Among his former students are Frances McDormand, Angela Bassett, Tony Shalhoub, Liev Shrieber, John Turturro, Patricia Clarkson, Chris Noth, Ricardo Chavira, Michael Urie and Jessica Chastain.
